

COLLINGWOOD ARTS & MUSIC FESTIVAL (CAMF) 2019

Location: Creative Simcoe Street, Collingwood, ON. Street will be closed to traffic.

CAMF is now a one day event taking place June 29, 2019, 9am to 6pm.

Set up will take place starting at 7am.

RULES & POLICIES

Applicants will pay as follows: BMFA Members a fee of \$60. Non BMFA Members a fee of \$70.

Youth Artists pay no fee, but must register. All applicants pay an extra \$5 per table, if needed.

Deadline to be eligible for Awards is May 31, 2019 for all Adult entries.

1. Applicants will be juried online for acceptance into CAMF. Please submit two photos of your artwork and a 50 word bio for review.
2. Your display and artwork will be judged during the event by several judges. Please ensure that the paintings you submitted photos of are brought to the show. Judges' scores will be totaled to determine award winners. Judging is based on: technique, originality, composition & presentation. Awards: Adults 1st \$200, 2nd \$100 3rd \$50, HM, Certificate only. Youths 1st \$100, 2nd \$ 75, 3rd \$50, HM, Certificate only.
3. Awards Ceremony to take place at 11:30am Saturday June 29, 2019. First place winner receives free entry into the following year. He/she is not eligible to be included in the judging for that year.
4. Artists may pay for one or two 10'x10'sites, providing extra spaces are available. The fee for the additional site will be \$25. BMFA Members may share a site with one other member for a \$10 extra charge, subject to change. Most sites will be on pavement. Please bring suitable weights to anchor your tent against wind.
5. Tables will be provided for a \$5 fee. Please reserve. You will be expected to help set up and take down your table.
6. Artists must commit to attendance for the full day 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Set up will take place starting at 7a.m. Saturday June and must be ready 15 minutes prior to opening. No artist may pack up and leave early except under exceptional circumstances. No vehicles will be allowed inside the closed off street between 9 in the morning and 6pm in the afternoon. If there are numerous visitors still in CAMF area we ask you delay bringing in your vehicle until the area is cleared.
7. There will be no commission charges levied at this event.
8. All items must be original artwork or craft designed and created by the vendor. Any photos used in artwork should be taken by the artist or credit must be given to the photographer. Any reproductions of art work must be numbered, except for art/greeting cards of one's own artwork.

9. No refund will be given for cancellations made after April 30, 2019, unless there is a waiting list and a vendor waiting to come into the event.
10. The bios and photos used at registration will be used to create the on-line Photo Gallery for the show.
11. Artists are responsible for their own sales, collection of applicable taxes and insurance, and for cleaning their site before leaving.
12. Artists should report their sales on a form inside the Artist's Envelope so organizers can judge how the event sales are doing for future planning purposes only.
13. It is the Artist's responsibility to carry insurance and to ensure their artwork is secure. CAMF Committee will be on site early on Friday evening June 28th. There could be 2-3 10'x10' sites on the grass. First come first served in this location and please request this area.
14. A copy of the card created for Creative Simcoe Street will be sent electronically to you for your use. Please forward to all your contacts. These cards will be available at the BMFA, 65 Simcoe St., Studio 4, by the end of May. Please feel free to pick some up for distribution. Downtown Collingwood BIA will print and provide 8"x10" posters. If you wish to pick up any posters for out of Town distribution they will be located at BMFA, 65 Simcoe St., Unit #4, Collingwood, ON by the end of May.
15. Music will be provided by local, well known Musicians. (To be arranged)
16. All participants please use the north parking lot on Ste. Marie Street. Parking is free on weekends. All participants must enter from Ste. Marie St. and turn onto Simcoe St. to load in your materials and leave the area from St. Paul St. You will be using the fire lane for set up. Please be courteous by unloading quickly to let others do the same. This lane must be kept clear for the **FIRE ROUTE** during the event.

The Town of Collingwood, Downtown Collingwood BIA, Blue Mountain Foundation for the Arts, Collingwood Arts & Music Festival, or any businesses owned by Rick & Anke Lex, workers or volunteers involved in CAMF are not responsible for any injury to yourself or damage to your artwork that might occur.
